A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 19.2-83.1 and 19.2-291.1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the
 Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 22.1-23.4 and 22.1-68.1, relating to reports of
 certain arrests and convictions of certain individuals to division superintendents; method of
 submission; compilation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

6 1. That §§ 19.2-83.1 and 19.2-291.1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that
7 the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 22.1-23.4 and 22.1-68.1 as follows:
8 § 19.2-83.1. Report of arrest of school employees and adult students for certain offenses.

9 A. Every state official or agency and every sheriff, police officer, or other local law-enforcement 10 officer or conservator of the peace having the power to arrest for a felony, upon arresting a person who 11 is known or discovered by the arresting official to be a full-time, part-time, permanent, or temporary 12 teacher or other employee in any public school division in this the Commonwealth for a felony or a 13 Class 1 misdemeanor or an equivalent offense in another state, shall file a report of such arrest with the 14 division superintendent of the employing division as soon as practicable. The contents of the report 15 required pursuant to this section shall be utilized by the local school division solely to implement the 16 provisions of subsection B of § 22.1-296.2 and § 22.1-315. Such report shall be submitted via fax and 17 email to the fax number and email address identified by the division superintendent pursuant to § 22.1-18 68.1.

B. Every state official or agency and every sheriff, police officer, or other local law-enforcement
officer or conservator of the peace having the power to arrest for a felony; shall file a report, as soon as
practicable, with the division superintendent of the school division in which the student is enrolled upon
arresting a person who is known or discovered by the arresting official to be a student age 18 or older in
any public school division in this the Commonwealth for:

36	9. Robbery pursuant to § 18.2-58;
37	10. Prohibited criminal street gang activity pursuant to § 18.2-46.2;
38	11. Recruitment of juveniles for criminal street gang pursuant to § 18.2-46.3;
39	12. An act of violence by a mob pursuant to § 18.2-42.1; or
40	13. Abduction of any person pursuant to § 18.2-47 or 18.2-48.
41	§ 19.2-291.1. Report of conviction of school employees for certain offenses.
42	The clerk of any circuit court or any district court in the Commonwealth shall report to the
43	Superintendent of Public Instruction and the division superintendent of any employing school division
44	the conviction of any person, known by such clerk to hold a license issued by the Board of Education,
45	for any felony involving the sexual molestation, physical or sexual abuse, or rape of a child or involving
46	drugs pursuant to Article 1 (§ 18.2-247 et seq.) of Chapter 7 of Title 18.2. Such report shall be submitted
47	via fax and email to the fax number and email address identified by the division superintendent pursuant
48	to § 22.1-68.1.
